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The Perspective(s) exhibition presents the artworks of students in SCALE, CAPE's After School Program, which includes K-12 students, families, and community members. Also presented is a Chicago mapping activity created with research partners at Creativity Labs/University of California Irvine.

CAPE pairs teaching artists with CPS teachers to develop an original curriculum that supports project-based arts-integrated learning. The SCALE program offers After School Classes to students and Community Classes to adults.

SCALE's research with Creativity Labs/University of California Irvine investigates Space, Openness, and Positionality themes in SCALE's arts-integrated practice.

This 2022-2023 school year, SCALE serves 8 schools, 342 students, and it works with 43 partnerships made up of 37 teaching artists and 46 CPS teachers and staff.
